## Full Membership Council Meeting Highlights

During the meeting, the new Charters and Bylaws were approved by membership voting with new variations to the documents. Major changes included members providing a primary and secondary POC to allow briefings and real-time sharing from DHS in a timely manner; the additional points of contact will assist in pulling RC3 members together quickly. Other changes included more opportunities for SMEs and affiliates to engage in RC3 matters.

New member candidate, the Cyber Resilience Institution, was voted on and approved as members. Cyber Resilience Institution enables communities, regional groups, and collaborative partnerships, across public and private institutions to respond to the National Call to Action.

Discussions were had on how to use public-private partnerships as a tool of information sharing. RC3 hopes to move from a think-tank component to an information sharing component and create a trusted environment for private sector partnerships.

## Cyber Working Group Highlights

Michael Echols, Department of Homeland Security, presented on the new ISAO Executive Order. It was announced that on March 4, a summit would take place for current ISACs, DHS, and ISAOs to have discussions on the Executive Order.

Discussions on two possible options for collaboration portals was held. The first option is through .NET. The National Council of ISACs (NCI) can create a private space for RC3, as they use this portal. NCI uses .NET, not SharePoint, that allows a post and view dialogue format. The second option is through the HSIN-CI portal that uses the SharePoint platform with layers of security. To obtain HSIN, RC3 needs to be federally endorsed by SLTTGCC; therefore, users would need to use the SLTTGCC website.
